- The exercises, practices and concepts discussed during training are sequenced according to adult education principles to deepen and accelerate your learning.
- Eight coaching competency modules are explored in segments where you will discuss theory and explore ICF requirements, observe demonstrations by a PCC coach, have ample opportunity to practice the skills, receive real-time feedback, reflect on what you are learning and become more intentional about how you can apply this learning going forward.
- Course materials are delivered to ensure the learning and application of coaching is relevant, meaningful and applicable in a variety of contexts (i.e. leaders as coaches, professional coaches, and specialized professionals who want to apply coaching skills and principles in their roles).
- During the course you will actively focus on skills practice. This will equip you to coach with the confidence and credibility that comes from a greater understanding and supervised practice.

What to Expect

- Six, 3.5-hour sessions designed to strengthen your current skills, help you integrate your learning at new levels, and demonstrate greater proficiency as a result.
- Enhanced coaching impact and preparation for your ACC or PCC accreditation process.
- A comprehensive Participant Workbook and additional resource materials.
- An opportunity to learn alongside other coaches, leaders and HR professionals.
- Instructional feedback and support by an experienced PCC coach.
- An evaluation of your coaching abilities and feedback on your areas for improvement.
